Wetherill Nature preserve

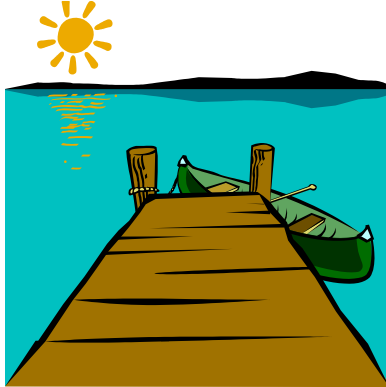
