Natural Gardening—By Sally B. Nordstrom

Many of us in Hunts Point are trying to restore the woods with native plants. Native woods do not require mowing, raking weeding, watering or fertilizing. Native plants have co-evolved with local insects, and birds and are adapted to the local climate optimizing their chance of survival. Your local nursery can help you determine which native plants will work best for your garden.

Follow nature and your garden will reward you, making clear air, a noise buffer and naturally filtering water runoff. By working together with nature we can preserve the native plants and trees of Hunts Point and help keep the lake water clean.
