**NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR SHORELINE MANAGEMENT
SUBSTANTIAL DEVELOPMENT PERMIT AND SEPA MITIGATED
DETERMINATION OF NON-SIGNIFICANCE**

Notice is hereby given that Greg Ashley, on behalf of Chris Bingham, has filed an application for a Shoreline Management Substantial Development Permit (#12-06) to install a dual jet-ski lift and a boat lift adjacent to an existing pier. The property is located at 3200 – 80th Avenue NE, King County, Washington. Said development is proposed to be within 200’ of Lake Washington or its associated wetlands.

Any person desiring to express his or her views or to be notified of the action taken on this application should contact Sue Israel, Deputy Clerk, 3000 Hunts Point Road, Hunts Point, WA 98004, in writing, of his or her interest within 30 days of this notice. In addition, the public is invited to a public hearing, to be scheduled at a later date. The Notice of Public Hearing will be posted and published once the hearing date is established.

The Town of Hunts Point issued a **MITIGATED DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE (MDNS)** under the State Environmental Policy Act Rules (Chapter 197-11 WAC) for the above project on July 19, 2012. After review of a completed environmental checklist and other information on file with the Town, the Town of Hunts Point determined that this proposal will not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment. Written comments on the MDNS will be accepted by the Town of Hunts Point until August 20, 2012.
