Medina to SR 202: Eastside Transit and HOV Project

92nd Avenue Northeast transit stop to reopen April 22

At 5 a.m. Monday, April 22, Eastside Corridor Constructors, working with Metro Transit, will reopen the 92nd Avenue Northeast eastbound freeway transit stop. The stop closed in summer 2012 and a shuttle has provided service between the Evergreen Point Road transit stop, the corner of 92nd Avenue Northeast and Points Drive Northeast.

Here are the details of transit stop opening:

- **Date opening:** 5 a.m. April 22
- **Location:** Eastbound SR 520 at 92nd Avenue Northeast
- **Metro trip planner website:** <http://tripplanner.kingcounty.gov/>

Work to reopen the transit stop will happen during the April 19-22 weekend closure of SR 520 between Montlake Boulevard in Seattle and I-405. This work is weather dependent and, in the event of heavy rain, may be delayed until the next weekend-long closure. The closure allows crews to make room for the next phase of highway construction by safely and efficiently shifting eastbound lanes to the south from Evergreen Point Road to 92nd Avenue Northeast.

Here are the details of the weekend closure:

- **When:** 11 p.m. Friday, April 19 to 5 a.m. Monday, April 22
- **Where:** Both directions of SR 520 and all ramps between Montlake Boulevard and I-405. SR 520 will remain open between Montlake Boulevard and I-5.
